




AFRICAN BUSH CAMPS FOUNDATION

The African Bush Camps Foundation aims to make a long-lasting impact in the communities and wildlife areas surrounding our camps and lodges by focusing on projects that support and enable communities, natural landscapes and wildlife to thrive and co-exist together.

We have projects running in Botswana, Zambia and Zimbabwe that are actively addressing challenges that include unemployment, food scarcity, education and school infrastructure, healthcare, wildlife poaching, human-wildlife coexistence and preserving natural resources.



Build a Boma

Lion Boma Project

The lion bomas are used to protect the community's livestock from predators and lions. A boma is a cloth material that is used to cover kraals so lions are unable to see the animals in the kraal, thus protecting the livestock inside from lions. By protecting the community's livestock from lions and other predators, we are reducing human-wildlife conflict in the area and retaliation killing of wildlife.

Build a Boma

You can partner with ABCF to erect a lion boma in Mambanje or Mola Village during your stay at Somalisa or Bumi Hills Safari Lodge. For a donation of \$2,000, ABCF will purchase a lion boma and guests will visit the village and partner with the community to erect the lion boma in the village. Build a Boma can be booked as part of the conservation impact safari or can be added to any booking that includes a stay at Somalisa or Bumi Hills.

BUILD A BOMA

Visit Mambanje or Mola Village during your stay at Somalisa or Bumi Hills Safari Lodge. The trip includes a visit to the Lion Boma Project and our foundation projects in the ara. You will get a tour of the projects to learn more about our work in the area and build a lion boma in the village. It takes about 1-hour to build the boma.

Things to bring:

- A hat and sunscreen.
- Wear comfortable working clothes and closed shoes.
 - · Working gloves.
- Cash should you wish to do some shopping in the village.

Should you wish to build a boma, a donation of **\$2,000** towards the foundation will apply which goes towards the cost of the lion boma. Groups bookings of 4 people or less will require a private vehicle which can be booked for a cost of **\$1500** and reserves a private vehicle and guide for you for the duration of your stay at our camp -up to 3 nights.
