### LADY JACQUELINE OVERVIEW

#### MIDDLE LEVEL

Guests aboard Lady Jacqueline from the stern and step into the air-conditioned main lounge cabin. At the bow, there's a refreshing plunge pool. Guests can walk freely around the boat's exterior, from bow to stern. This level also houses the Captain's control area and kitchen.

#### LOWER LEVEL

Lady Jacqueline's lower level is complete with two air-conditioned queen-size bedrooms, each boasting their own en-suite bathroom. Additionally, there are two cozy bunk rooms equipped with fans, sleeping two and four guests – perfect for children. An extra bathroom is easily accessible via the air-conditioned corridor.

#### UPPER LEVEL

The stairs at the stern lead up to the viewing deck, which features a dining table and comfortable seating area – ideal for enjoying cocktails, card games, reading, and spotting wildlife. The deck is equipped with drinks cabinets, so guests can relax and enjoy stunning views in this perfect leisurely setting.

#### CREW

The crew consists of a captain, a chef, a deckhand, and a professional guide from Bumi Hills Safari Lodge.





## LUNCH AND CRUISE EXPERIENCE

### Rates & Bookings

- The lunch cruise experience is included in the rate for international guests.
- The rate for SADC guests is \$175 per adult and \$87.50 per child aged between 12 and 15 years old.
- The experience requires a minimum two-night stay at Bumi Hills Safari Lodge to ensure that your cruise day does not coincide with a travel day.

### Departure

- Lady Jacqueline usually departs at 11 AM and returns at 3 PM.

### Guest Capacity & Exclusive Use

- The maximum number of guests is eight, including both adults and children over 12 years of age.
- A minimum of two adults is required to book.
- For your group's exclusive use of Lady Jacqueline, a minimum of four adults is required. Please note that if your party is under four people, you may share the boat with other guests.
- Alternatively, if your group has fewer than four adults, you can still book the boat for exclusive use by paying \$175 for each adult up to the four-adult minimum.

## OVERNIGHT CRUISE AND SLEEPOUT EXPERIENCE

### Rates and Bookings

- This experience is included in the rate for international guests.
- The rate for SADC guests is \$375 per adult and \$187.50 per child aged between 12 and 15 years old.
- The experience requires a minimum three-night stay at Bumi Hills Safari Lodge to ensure that your cruise day does not coincide with a travel day.

### Departure

- Lady Jacqueline usually departs at 3 PM and returns the following day at 10:30 AM.

### Activities

- Walking safari in Matusadona National Park (not suitable for children under the age of 16).
- Explore the shoreline from our tender boat - ideal for game viewing, fishing, and sunset cruises.

### Guest Capacity & Exclusive Use

- The maximum number of guests is eight, accommodating four adults and four children over 12 years old.
- A minimum of two adults is required to book.
- For your group's exclusive use of Lady Jacqueline, a minimum of four adults is required. Please note that if your party is under four people, you may share the boat with other guests.
- Alternatively, if your group has fewer than four adults, you can still book the boat for exclusive use by paying \$375 for each adult up to the four-adult minimum.

## ADDITIONAL NOTES

### Bookings

- When booking, guests must choose either the sleepout or the lunch experience, as only one option can be reserved on a first-come, first-served basis.

### Age Limit

- For safety reasons, we cannot accommodate children under the age of 12 aboard Lady Jacqueline.

### Weather Considerations

- Please note, in conditions of wind, rain, or an approaching storm, the boat may not operate. Even with mild wind, expect slight rolling motions due to the waves.
