



## KHWAI COMMUNITY AREA, BOTSWANA

Set within the Okavango's community-run Khwai Concession, this beautiful camp is tucked under the trees on the edge of the Khwai River. The elegantly designed camp hosts 6 Meru tents, keeping in line with the intimate and exclusive wilderness experience. Weaving baskets and beaded decor along with modern elements, brings an authentic contemporary African style. In the daytime, guests can enjoy game drives, mokoro (water levels permitting) and walking safaris on the search for Africa's big attractions including lion, cheetah, leopard, wild dog, elephant, buffalo, hippo and giraffe. An additional beauty of this area is that guests can head off on night drives get an up-close and personal experience with some of Africa's nocturnal and more elusive animals.
