Edging the Moremi Game Reserve, the camp will offer a range of immersive activities including mokoro adventures, game drives beneath the sun and stars, and walking safaris among abundant wildlife.

"Khwai Leadwood is the Okavango Delta extension of the old African experience that shapes our camps," says Beks Ndlovu, a veteran professional guide who established African Bush Camps in 2006.

Khwai Leadwood combines luxurious modern finishes in one of the most culturally dynamic areas in the world. Renowned as one of the leading wildlife areas in southern Africa, Moremi Game Reserve covers more than 40 percent of the Okavango. It is home to most predator species including wild dogs, leopards, hyena, and lions.

Khwai Leadwood will be the 15th luxury camp from African Bush Camps, a luxury tent Safari operator in Botswana, Zambia and Zimbabwe.



Intimate and sustainably built, the camp features six luxury twin/double tents and one family unit with capacity for 16 people. All rooms are designed for comfort and modern amenities include cooling fans, charging facilities, and private en suite bathrooms. Outfitted with indoor and outdoor showers, and private decks with day beds and a shading canvas overhang, the tents ensure a year-round at-home feel pleasantly 'disconnected' from the hustle and bustle of working life.

Additional features include fresh, expertly prepared cuisine served at the communal dining deck. Special menu requests are happily tended to for all dietary requirements.

The lounge and reading area feature a nearby bar serving African-inspired cocktails as well as wine and beer. The camp's swimming pool will be a popular spot to chill out and sip sundowners after daylong ventures in the bush.
