Join hands-on initiatives to reduce human-wildlife conflict, from building lion bomas that shield livestock from predators to helping regenerate farmland. You'll learn from the dedicated anti-poaching teams, lion guardians, and park rangers working to safeguard our National Parks and empower communities in conservation. The safari concludes in Zambia's Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park, where you'll join rangers on a rhino trekking experience to observe a crash of protected white rhinos. Witness these magnificent animals up close while learning about their behavior and the conservation efforts that keep them safe.

Day 1

- Scheduled safari aircraft flight from HRE to Dandawa Airstrip.
- Game drive transfer from Dandawa Airstrip to Kanga Expeditions.

Kanga Expeditions x 2 nights

Day 3

- Game drive transfer from Kanga Expeditions to Zambezi Expeditions or Nyamatusi Camp.

Zambezi Expeditions or Nyamatusi Camp x 2 nights

Day 5

- Game drive transfer from Zambezi Expeditions or Nyamatusi Camp to Mana Main Airstrip.
- Scheduled safari aircraft flight from Mana Main Airstrip to Bumi Airstrip.
- Game drive transfer from Bumi Airstrip to Bumi Hills Safari Lodge.

Bumi Hills Safari Lodge x 3 nights

Day 8

- Game drive transfer from Bumi Hills Safari Lodge to Bumi Airstrip.
- Scheduled safari aircraft flight from Bumi Airstrip to VFA.
- Road transfer from VFA to Thorntree River Lodge.

Thorntree River Lodge x 2 nights

Day 10

- Road transfer from Thorntree River Lodge to LVI.



Included Camp Activities

Kanga Expeditions: Morning and afternoon game drives, walking safaris*, the 'armchair safari', and use of the photographic hide (subject to Kanga Pan water levels).

Zambezi Expeditions: Morning and afternoon game drives, canoeing safaris*, walking safaris*, and catch-and-release shore fishing.

Bumi Hills Safari Lodge: Morning, afternoon, and night game drives, walking safaris*, catch-and-release seasonal fishing, along with sunrise, midday, and sunset boat cruises.

Thorntree River Lodge: Sunrise and sunset boat cruises, guided visits to the Zambian side of the Falls (including entrance fees) and to the Zimbabwean side during the low water season (excluding visa fees), canoeing safaris*, a rhino walk*, game drives in Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park, and catch-and-release seasonal fishing.

Foundation Project: Build a Lion Boma | Bumi Hills Anti-Poaching Unit

The trip includes a visit to the Lion Boma Project, Bumi Hills Anti Poach Unit, and our foundation projects in the area. You will get a tour of the projects to learn more about our work in the area and build a lion boma in the village.

Foundation Volunteer Activity:

Build a Lion Boma

Travel and Activity Time:

4 hour activity including building the boma and refreshments are provided.
Transfer by vehicle: 2-hour travel time including the game drive.



Thorntree River Lodge

Foundation Project: Rhino Walk Experience

The trip includes a visit to the rhino trekking project in Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park where a crash of white rhinos is under 24-hour protection by rangers to conserve them. You will get to witness these magnificent animals up close and learn about their behavior and the conservation efforts to keep them safe.

Travel and Activity Time:

1.5 hour activity and refreshments are provided

Transfer by vehicle: 30 minutes travel time
